
This year, 473 Sudanese gathered from Lincoln, Omaha, and Grand Island to worship at Christ Lincoln in our Sanctuary worship space.

Average weekly giving to the General Fund was \$52,552.75 vs targeted average weekly giving to the General Fund which was \$59,076.93.

Our revenue this year is better than last year, but does not fully fund the ministry we are providing.

Therefore, staff are working off a revised budget that matches our projected revenue through the end of the year.
