FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY

In order to promote fiscal responsibility, we have taken a few steps within our church and Lay Leadership Board (LLB):

- Developed financial procedures for approving expenses, and guidelines for all dedicated accounts.
- 2. Budgeted our Sumner debt interest in our General Fund.
- Developed an "All-in" budget approach, approved by our LLB, to better communicate the real cost of ministry with our congregation.
- 4. Held our first Financial Town Hall meeting, to be held quarterly.
- 5. We look to make our treasurer a non-voting member on the LLB.
