#### 'Adoration'

## *`Confession'*

**Proverbs 28:13**; "Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy."

We were born, sinful and unclean, through no fault of our own, but because of the sins of our parents, grandparents...Adam and Eve.

**1 Corinthians 12:18-20**; "But now God has placed the members, each one of them, in the body, just as He desired. If they were all one member, where would the body be? But now there are many members, but one body."

Keep us ever thankful of Your presence in our weakness.

*Heavenly Father, we come to You now with hearts, minds and words filled with 'Thanksgiving'."* 

- We give thanks for our Creator, Redeemer and Holy Spirit.
- We give You thanks for protecting inhabitants on the Ilse of Hispaniola from the tropical storms thus far this year.
- We give thanks for this new school year and the many additional students in new schools who will learn about Jesus and receive a daily meal from Trinity HOPE.
- As we give of our first fruits may we also give a portion of our best to His children in Haiti who need the assistance we can provide because of You.
- We give thanks for Your wisdom and directions for our Board of Directors who desire to feed many more children and increase the number of Your missionaries within Haiti.

#### 'Supplications'

**Psalm 51:1–2**; "Be gracious to me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness; according to the greatness of Your compassion blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin."

Father, these verses should remind each of us that every morning, You give us a fresh start to walk with You. There are over 40,000 children in Haiti who will hopefully resume their classes on September 6<sup>th</sup> and learn more about You and share that of salvation with those still clinging to the lies of vodou. Lord, we live in a dry and barren world, where sin is becoming more and more rampant and society is so filthy; we need a fountain of fresh, clean water full of blessing, truth, and strength; we need a fresh start.

Father, we are thirsty today for the living water. May it do its work in cleansing us and this world. May it wash our minds, may it cleanse our motives, may it scrub away the shameful secrets of our private world so that You can lead us onto right paths. We have a history of being prone to wander and leave the God we love. And only Your cleansing, fresh water of the Spirit can make us clean deep within and provide a fresh start within us. We give ourselves to Your sacred work, to be set apart for Your best use, for Your greater glory.

Heavenly Father, we bring our supplications before You;

- *Heavenly Father, please place your healing hands upon Your servants in Haiti who are facing physical challenges from COVID-19.*
- Lord Jesus, bring a calming breeze and a fresh start throughout Haiti before the start of this new school year. Bring truth, peace and wisdom to their government and a desire to seek and follow YOU more closely every day.
- May the charcoal fires started by the cooks snuff out the lies of the vodou priests and bring those who still cling to those lies to the foot of the cross.
- Creator of the universe, please provide shelter and comfort for those who were affected by earthquake last month and shield those who are in path of any additional Tropical storms that are forming. Please keep all Your chosen protected in the coming months.
- Father, please dissolve the gangs that are blocking the main highway from Port-au-Prince to main cities in the southern claw of Haiti. May Your people rise up and reclaim this road and restore peace so that commerce and emergency assistance can once again bring needed necessities to Your people.

- Heavenly Father, please bless new donors unknown to us but who are out there ready to help to feed Haitian children who are attending the additional new schools.
- Father, provide Trinity HOPE team members in the US who oversee the monthly records from all of the Haitian schools with abundant joy as they serve you in this way.

Lord God, bless Your Word wherever it is proclaimed. Make it a Word of power and peace to convert those not yet Your own and to confirm those who have come to saving faith. May Your Word pass from the ear to the heart, from the heart to the lip and from the lip to the life that, as You have promised, Your Word may achieve the purpose for which You sent it; through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.
