#### **'Adoration'**

**Psalm 5:8;** "O LORD, lead me in Your righteousness because of my foes; make Your way straight before me."

*Heavenly Father, for centuries since the beginning of time, You have used Your Word in the hearts of men and women in different cultures and countries throughout this fallen world. You have sent to difficult and obscure places faith-filled missionaries, fathers and mothers and school children with the Word of God tucked away in their hearts. Your children, young and old; they have declared it, and You have blessed their witness by Your Holy Spirit. Your Holy Word has spread like a holy wildfire, and, as Your children, we are in awe of Your faithfulness.*

*A time of 'Adoration' to our Triune God.*

- *During this Fall season of your life, consider the abundant provisions, protection, hope and love that surround you because of His unfailing love for you.*
- *Stop and reflect upon the immense work that our Creator has already done and is still doing in the lives of each Haitian child who are happily walking to their Christian school this month and are receiving daily manna from Heaven.*
- *Consider how our God is using your time, talents and treasures.*

#### **'Confession'**

**1 John 1:9;** "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."

*We were born, sinful and unclean, through no fault of our own, but because of the sins of our parents, grandparents...Adam and Eve.*

*God sent His only Son to die for our sins. Jesus did everything right while he was here on this earth. He loves you with a love that cannot be measured. He gave to the world when no thanks were returned to Him. He healed when there was no hope, and He died without complaint. Jesus did nothing wrong and everything right; all this for you. **Psalm 107:1**; "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever."

- *We give You thanks for our providence and as we give of our first fruits may we also give a portion of our best to His children in Haiti who need the assistance we can provide because of You.*

### **'Supplications'**

**Matthew 6:24, 33**; "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth...but seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."

*Father, we thank You for giving us our vocations; for the privilege of making a living. - May the fires started by the Trinity HOPE school cooks scorch the lies of the vodou priests and bring those who still cling to those lies to the foot of the cross seeking Your forgiveness, favor and direction for their new lives serving You.*
- Father, provide ample teams of volunteers with Trinity HOPE who oversee the monthly records from the increased list of Haitian school's abundant joy as they serve you in this way.*
- Father, restore the broken and damaged homes, schools and churches in Haiti and protect Your children from new storms that may again challenge their lives.*

*Lord God, bless Your Word wherever it is proclaimed. Make it a Word of power and peace to convert those not yet Your own and to confirm those who have come to saving faith. May Your Word pass from the ear to the heart, from the heart to the lip and from the lip to the life*
