Additionally, the Videographer manages all video equipment to ensure it is maintained and ready for use.

 - B. Support digital engagement by designing video assets for the website, worship services and social media platforms.
 - C. Develop innovative and engaging video content that enhances communication and inspires the congregation, families and the community.
 - D. Stay up-to-date with video production trends and implement modern techniques to elevate the ministry's visual storytelling.
- II. Collaboration & Project Execution
 - A. Partner with Ministry Leaders to capture their vision and ensure alignment with ministry goals.
 - B. Manage multiple projects simultaneously, balancing ministry priorities and timelines effectively.

Physical Requirements

Comfortable standing, sitting, and moving around for extended periods while operating video equipment. Manual dexterity is necessary for handling cameras, tripods, lighting, and other production gear. Occasional lifting and carrying of equipment and supplies up to 50 lbs may be required. Ability to adjust and set up equipment in a variety of indoor and outdoor settings is essential. Good eyesight is important for monitoring video and audio quality. Adequate hearing is necessary for communication with team members and ministry leaders. Clear verbal communication skills are important for collaborating effectively. Flexibility to work evenings and weekends as needed to support events and productions may be needed.
